- Ensure the engagement of personnel who are HSE competent and committed to safety.
- Enlighten all staff about the HSE policies and its relevance to their work activities.
- Conduct all tasks in the work scope with safety and environmental consciousness in mind.
- Ensure Risk Assessment is carried out and preventive actions are in place before commencing activities.
- Ensure all workers are equipped with adequate and appropriate PPE.
- Monitor HSE performances through scheduled audit / inspections.
- Ensure personnel have clearly defined and achievable tasks and targets aimed at improving HSE performance.
- Prevent personnel injuries and other losses due to emergencies through an emergency preparedness and response plan
- Prevent accidents/incidents through a program of a root cause analysis and cascade lessons learned.
- Reduce HSE incidents caused by equipment failure or human error by ensuring regular maintenance of equipment and training of personnel.
- Improve personnel awareness on Occupational Health, Safety and Environmental issues.
- Review HSE policies to make individual staff accountable / empowered to ensure that good HSE practice is in place prior to commencing work
